

Foundations Spelling Words

Since Logic of English teaches students why words are spelled the way they are, none of the *Foundations* spelling words are taught as sight words to be guessed or memorized by rote. Instead, students learn how to decode and encode high frequency words in the context of systematic, linguistically accurate phonics instruction.
